

Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive Intersection Upgrade Project

Site investigation activities

Ground investigations works are continuing at the intersection of Marion Road and Sir Donald Bradman Drive to assist with planning for the intersection upgrade.

These investigations will provide an understanding of the underlying soil and groundwater conditions to inform the early planning and design phase. The works will involve a mobile drill rig undertaking soil samples at various locations.

Works will be undertaken Thursday, 13 July and Friday, 14 July 2023 between 10am and 3pm at various locations through and around the intersection, weather permitting.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practicably possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works.

There will be no impacts to bus stops in the vicinity of the investigations.
