

Kangaroo Island Ports Upgrade

Cape Jervis Public Jetty

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the ports at Penneshaw and Cape Jervis to enable the new ferries to safely deliver services between Kangaroo Island (KI) and the mainland. This project is funded by the South Australian Government.

The berthing and mooring structures at the port of Cape Jervis and the port of Penneshaw form part of the critical link between KI and the mainland for cars, freight, and passengers.

Effective, capable, and reliable port infrastructure at Cape Jervis and Penneshaw is critical to the welfare and economic success of KI.

To safely upgrade and operate the new port facility at Cape Jervis, which will accommodate the new ferry vessels, it has been determined that the existing public jetty at Cape Jervis cannot be retained.

To ensure public safety, it has also been determined that it would be impractical to construct a replacement jetty at this same location.

The Department will commence exploring alternative options for recreational fishing with the District Council of Yankalilla and other key stakeholders.

In addition to this, the Department is also developing a broader masterplan for the Cape Jervis harbour area. The preliminary work on this plan has been informed by initial stakeholder engagement. The Department intends to further engage with key stakeholders and the community in the coming months to progress the development of this masterplan. Completion of this masterplan will guide future development of the precinct and inform future funding considerations for all levels of Government.
