

# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Hone Street permanent access changes

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, right turn movements at the junction of Hone Street and Fullarton Road will be **permanently removed from 6am Wednesday, 13 September 2023**.

### What to expect

A solid median will be constructed on Fullarton Road, preventing right turn movements in and out of Hone Street.

The removal of this right turn is required to provide improved traffic flow and efficiency, facilitating three through-lanes and a right turn lane onto Glen Osmond at the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection.

### New access arrangements

Left hand turn movements in and out of Hone Street will not be impacted.

Vehicles can continue to use existing alternative local roads. Please refer to the map overleaf for details.
