Dukes Highway works update

We are delivering upgrades to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes across the state. The \$500 million program is funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments over 10 years.

What's happening:

We are undertaking pavement works to improve road safety and rideability on the Dukes Highway between Bordertown and the Victorian border.

How this affects you:

To do these works safely, Dukes Highway will be reduced to a single lane with speed restrictions and onsite traffic controllers in place to help manage the flow of traffic.

Speed restrictions will also be required during work hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, Dukes Highway will be fully reopened with speed restrictions remaining in place. Speed restrictions will also remain in place until line marking is fully complete.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

All works including line marking are now expected to be completed in late May 2024.
