

The Golden Way and The Grove Shopping Centre Access Junction Pedestrian Improvements

Commencement of works notice

We are improving pedestrian safety on The Golden Way in Golden Grove

This project is one of eight locations identified across South Australia for upgrade as part of a broader strategy to improve road safety for all pedestrians but in particular children walking to and from school.

What's happening

We are upgrading the junction of The Golden Way with The Grove Shopping Centre access, Golden Grove. This project will improve pedestrian safety, particularly for pedestrians accessing Gleeson College, Golden Grove High School and Pedare Christian College.

The project will include:

- Addition of a left turn lane within the traffic signals (removal of the left slip lane) allowing pedestrians to cross without needing to wait at a traffic island.
- Upgraded lighting to improve visibility.
- Upgraded pedestrian ramps to improve safety and accessibility (including around Tenison Place and The Golden Way junction).
- Minor pavement upgrades.
- Drainage improvements.

How this affects you

The Golden Way will remain open to traffic at all times during the works and access to The Grove Shopping Centre will be maintained.

To reduce traffic impacts the majority of works will be undertaken at night. Day works will be undertaken intermittently as required for the duration of the project.

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during working hours. Please plan your trips and follow the direction of on-site traffic controllers. Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours until all works are completed.

Traffic management will be carefully coordinated between these works and the ongoing upgrades to The Grove Way, Atlantis Drive and Aeolian Drive, and The Grove Way and The Golden Way intersections to minimise impacts as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious, some areas might have limited access for safety. Onsite signage will be in place to guide you to alternative routes.

Some property access may be temporarily impacted during the night works, but we will do our best to maintain access to businesses in the area. The project team will contact affected property owners, residents, and businesses directly in advance.
