Regency Road to Pym Street – Night Works

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The South Australian and Australian Governments announced joint funding for the construction of a new section of the North-South Corridor, Regency Road to Pym Street. This will connect the already completed South Road Superway and the Torrens Road to River Torrens Project, which is due for completion later this year. Once the Torrens Road to River Torrens and Northern Connector Projects have been completed in 2018 and 2019, the Regency Road to Pym Street Project will complete a 47km non-stop roadway between Gawler and the River Torrens.

The Australian and South Australian Governments have committed \$354m to construct the Regency Road to Pym Street Project (R2P) as part of their overall commitment to deliver a 78 km non-stop North-South Corridor from Gawler to Noarlunga. The R2P project will commence in 2019 with completion in 2022.

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of night works for utility service investigations along South Road, between Regency Road and Pym Street.

Night works will occur on the following nights, weather permitting.

- Monday 13 August from 7pm to 6am
- Tuesday 14 August from 7pm to 6am

The works will involve pavement and geotechnical investigations to provide information for the detailed design of the Regency Road to Pym Street Project.

These works are being undertaken at night in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the work safely and efficiently.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. A 25 km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents, however, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are undertaken.
