

Gorge Road and Silkes Road Junction upgrade

Dear Resident / Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) will be improving the safety and functionality of the intersection at Gorge Road and Silkes Road. This \$3.6m project is being delivered by the State Government to improve safety for all road users, particularly for those turning right from Silkes Road onto Gorge Road.

The project will include:

- the installation of traffic signals at the Gorge Road and Silkes Road junction; and
- widening along Gorge Road and at the corners of Gorge Road with both Silkes Road and Pattinson Road.

Major construction works are scheduled to commence in the second quarter of 2021 with project completion expected by the end of 2021.
