

Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Fullarton Road permanent removal of right turn

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity, and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, the right turn from Fullarton Road into Glen Osmond Road (citybound) will be **permanently removed from 6am on Tuesday, 26 September 2023**.

The removal of this movement is required to provide improved traffic flow and efficiency through the Glen Osmond Road/Fullarton Road intersection which is currently being upgraded.

Advance notice signage will be in place on the approach to Greenhill Road and Fullarton Road intersection, to advise road users of the change in conditions.

The right turn from Fullarton Road into Glen Osmond Road (heading towards the South Eastern Freeway) is being retained.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation whilst these important changes are implemented.
