

East Parklands Road Upgrades

Hutt Street and Bartels Road Intersection

General maintenance works are required to remediate sections of the East Parklands area to improve the road surface and safety for all users.

What's happening:

Maintenance activities will include pavement removal and new asphalt resurfacing on the southern corner of the Bartels Road/Hutt Street intersection.

How this affects you:

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be required. Please follow onsite traffic signage and follow the direction of traffic controllers while works are in progress.

We will directly contact residents and businesses located in the work area to advise of any parking and/or access restrictions because of works.

Some Adelaide Metro bus services and bus stops within the works area may be temporarily impacted while works are undertaken. Please observe bus stop signage and visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au.

Pedestrians and cyclists might also need to use a different path during the works; however, signs will show you where to go.

During the works, there will be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.
