Night works

The South Australian Government has committed \$9.9 million to upgrade the Ethelton Railway Station. The upgrade will include new and more accessible platforms, improving passenger safety and experience.

What's happening

We will be working on the rail corridor to get ready for pouring concrete for the new platform.

From Sunday 29 September to Friday 4 October 2024, work will be undertaken after the last train of the day and before the first train the next morning.

From Friday 4 October to Tuesday 8 October 2024, work will be ongoing both day and night while the trains are not running. Substitute buses will be available during this period.

How this affects you

Please follow traffic management directions on Wirra Drive and Causeway Road while works are in progress. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.

To accommodate the works, there will be some temporary closures along the Outer Harbor Line between Woodville and Outer Harbour Stations.
