



# Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

## Night Works Notification

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Springbank, Daws and Goodwood roads. The \$61 million project, jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments, will improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users.

Your patience during these important works is appreciated with the project recently reaching a major milestone with the new four-way intersection open to traffic in late April 2021.

The next stage of work is:

- The installation of drainage along Goodwood Road, just north of the new intersection.
- The laying of new asphalt along Goodwood Road, between just south of Jamestown Avenue and Rockville Avenue, and along Springbank Road, between Goodwood Road and Daniels Road.

While the majority of works will be undertaken during the day, night works are required to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Night works will be undertaken **from Sunday, 16 May 2021, through to Friday 18 June, 2021**, weather permitting.

Hours of work are between **7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday. No works will be undertaken on Saturday nights.**

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will also be in place during these works.

The new intersection will remain open to traffic at all times other than on **Monday, 7 June 2021 and Tuesday, 8 June 2021 from 7pm to 6am when access to Springbank Road will be closed between Daniels Road and the new intersection.** Local access will be maintained at all times for residents, buses and emergency services vehicles.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, however, at times this will be under the assistance of traffic controllers.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
