



Salisbury Highway Asphalt Resurfacing

Night works and changed traffic conditions

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport will be undertaking approximately 5.5km of asphalt resurfacing works on Salisbury Highway, between Elder Smith Road, Mawson Lakes and the connection with the Port River Expressway, Wingfield. Works will also include the Port Wakefield Road and Salisbury Highway on and off ramps.

This project is funded under the State Government's Metro Road Stimulus Program and the Periodic Maintenance Program.

The works will be undertaken in two stages. Stage one, between Elder Smith Road (west of the intersection with Salisbury Highway) and west of the Port Wakefield Road overpass will commence from **Monday, 13 September 2021, for approximately eight weeks, weather permitting**. See map below.

To minimise impacts to road users, the majority of Stage one works will be undertaken at night, **Sunday to Friday between 7pm to 6am**.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place. Restrictions will also remain during the day, subject to on site conditions. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

A series of detours will be in place intermittently during works at the Port Wakefield Road and Salisbury Highway on and off ramps. Advance notice of detours will be provided via the Department's Facebook page www.facebook.com/DFITSA and on site electronic messaging boards.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Access to businesses will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict access.

Businesses will remain open. Please continue to support local businesses.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Advance notice will be provided prior to Stage two works commencing. Stage two will be undertaken between west of Port Wakefield Road and the Port River Expressway connection.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience while these important works are undertaken.

This project is expected to be complete late December 2021, weather permitting.
