

Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Gladstone Street Service Works

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, the existing overhead SA Power Networks (SAPN) infrastructure (stobie poles and overhead connections) near the project area will be removed and connected to a new underground network. Works to install the new underground network along Fullarton Road will be undertaken across Campbell Road in the coming weeks.

What to expect

Works will involve service locating, trench excavation and installation of new SAPN infrastructure. The works will occur on the northern side of Gladstone Street, adjacent Fullarton Road and have currently been scheduled to take place from Tuesday, 14 June 2022, through to Tuesday, 5 July 2022, weather permitting. These works will take place from Monday to Saturday, between the hours of 7am and 5pm.

To safely facilitate these works, **traffic on Gladstone Street will be temporarily reduced to one lane through the work zone and there will be no exit from Gladstone Street onto Fullarton Road. Vehicles will need to exit via Glen Osmond Road. Entry to Gladstone Street from Fullarton Road will continue to be available.** Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. Access for properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
