

Freight Highway Upgrade Program

Temporary Rest Area Closure, Augusta Highway

We are delivering upgrades to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes across the state. The \$500 million program is funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments over 10 years.

What's happening:

We are undertaking shoulder works along both sides of the Augusta Highway, between Snowtown and Collinsfield, to improve safety and increase the lifespan of the road pavement.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, the rest area will temporarily be closed to all traffic while the work is being undertaken.

During this time, motorists and heavy vehicle operators will be able to use the nearest rest areas at the Shell Roadhouse in Snowtown and the rest area between Sinclairs Road and Riverglen Road, approximately 30km north on Augusta Highway. These rest areas will accommodate all types of heavy vehicles.

The Augusta Highway will remain open at all times. Access to the rest area will be reinstated each day from 5pm during the works.
