# John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

**Commencement of works notice** 

We are upgrading the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale.

This forms part of the State Government's election commitments to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs.

# What's happening

Works are shortly starting construction on the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road, Elizabeth Vale. These works include construction of a new dedicated right turn lane onto Haydown Road from John Rice Avenue, traffic light installation and upgraded road surfaces to improve traffic flow and safety for all road users.

Site establishment will start on Monday, 16 September 2024, on Everleigh Road during the day, with night works commencing from Monday, 30 September 2024.

# How this affects you

Day works, including service location, landscaping and vegetation removals will start from **Monday**, **16 September 2024** and take approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

To minimise impacts to road users the majority of major works will be undertaken at **night**, **from Monday**, **30 September 2024**.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area for the duration of works. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours until all works are complete.
