The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler to improve safety and traffic efficiency for all road users.

What's happening

We are undertaking pavement rehabilitation works on the Sturt Highway overtaking lanes, between Halfway House Road and Liebigs Road, Steinfeld.

How this affects you

The Sturt Highway will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, there will be changes to traffic conditions. The westbound overtaking lane will be closed for the duration of works, with speed restrictions in place throughout the area.

Traffic restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours until all works are complete. Please plan your trips, observe onsite signage and follow the direction of traffic controllers.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while we undertake these important works.
