

Drayton and Chief Street Pocket Parks

Demolition and Remediation

We are preparing and returning vacant land at Chief and Drayton Street to City of Charles Sturt to be used for future pocket parks.

What's happening

Works to remediate Chief and Drayton Street pocket park locations will start on Monday 12 May and are expected to be completed mid-2025.

The works will involve:

- site compound establishment,
- survey and service location works,
- demolition and disposal of the asphalt and concrete surfaces, excavation works,
- placement of clean topsoil suitable for future landscaping and tree planting works.

What to expect

We will plan our works to try to minimise the impact as much as possible and will typically undertake the works during the day. We will work with the directly affected residents to understand their needs and minimise the impact as much as possible.

There may be some noise, dust and vibrations disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise, dust and vibrations to a minimum.

Traffic impacts

There may be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe while works are underway. We urge everyone to follow traffic management directions. Pedestrians and cyclists are encouraged to take care when travelling through the area.
