

Flinders Link Project

Night Works

As part of the Flinders Link Project, night works will be undertaken in the rail corridor between Clovelly Park and Tonsley Station from 8pm, Friday, 28 June, until 6am, Monday, 1 July 2019.

Works will involve:

- Termination of the railway line at Clovelly Park Station and installation of a buffer stop;
- Removal of overhead wiring between Clovelly Park and Tonsley Station;
- Removal of rail track on the south side of Alawoona Avenue; and
- Signalling and communication installation, testing and commissioning.

As part of the works, a temporary closure of Alawoona Avenue will be required, between Bradley Grove and MAB Circuit, from 8pm, Friday, 28 June until 7am, Saturday, 29 June, while the overhead wiring line is lowered. Signage will be in place to alert motorists of the changed traffic conditions.

Traffic and speed restrictions will apply in the vicinity of the works for the remainder of the weekend. Road users are asked to use extra caution when workers are on site. Pedestrian access along Alawoona Avenue will be maintained at all times, with the exception of a short period of time on Friday night whilst overhead wires are transferred.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are undertaken however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible.
