South Eastern Freeway - Managed Motorway Measures Project: Night works and Crafers On-Ramp Closure

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

Night works including removal of temporary concrete traffic barriers, asphalt and temporary line marking for the South Eastern Freeway - Managed Motorway Measures Project will commence from Tuesday, 25 August, to Friday, 11 September 2020, weather permitting.

The South Eastern Freeway - Managed Motorway Project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian Governments. The project will convert the existing emergency lane into a third full time travel lane and implement a Managed Motorway on both the citybound (Stirling to Crafers) and outbound (Crafers to Stirling) carriageways of the South Eastern Freeway between Crafers and Stirling. This will enable the allocation and control of lanes across the Freeway to improve safety and traffic flow.

In order to minimise impact to road users, the works will be undertaken at night between 7pm and 6am from Monday to Friday, commencing Tuesday, 25 August 2020. No works will be undertaken on Saturday or Sunday nights.

The Freeway will remain open to traffic at all times during the night works, with a 40km/h speed restriction in place. Lane restrictions will also be in place with road users restricted to one lane in each direction.

The works will also require the closure of the outbound Crafers on-ramp on the dates listed below.

- Monday, 31 August, between 12:00am and 6:00am to remove concrete barriers
- Tuesday, 1 September, between 7:00pm and 6:00am for excavation to pavement base
- Monday, 7 September, between 7:00pm and 6:00am for placement of asphalt
- Tuesday, 8 September, between 7:00pm and 6:00am for placement of asphalt.

Detours will be in place during the works (see map overleaf).

Road users are asked to please plan ahead and allow extra travel time, observe speed limits, lane restrictions, traffic controllers and take extra care when travelling through the area and on any detours.



Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses as much as practically possible.
