

## Start of works - Stebonheath Road and Womma Road Intersection Upgrade

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is installing a single lane roundabout at the intersection of Stebonheath Road and Womma Road, Edinburgh North to improve road safety and traffic efficiency for all road users.

Other works as part of the \$5.1 million State Government funded project include:

- Pavement construction and surfacing.
- New median and kerb and gutter construction.
- New pedestrian refuges and ramps.
- New line marking.
- Upgraded LED lighting for the extent of the works.
- Vegetation removal and landscaping.
- New signage on all approaches, and within the roundabout footprint.

Works will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, from Monday, 1 March 2021, and are expected to be complete late July 2021, weather permitting. Night works may be required during the project and adjacent residents and businesses will be provided with advance notice.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Roads will remain open to traffic during construction, with a 25km/h speed restriction in place while workers are on-site. Lane and other speed restrictions may apply, subject to onsite conditions. Road users are asked to please take extra caution when workers are on site.

The Department appreciates your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
