

John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

Site investigation works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is conducting site investigation works at the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road, as part of the State Government's election commitment, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and make travel easier for all users.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to provide feedback on the proposed concept design for the John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade. This feedback will help inform the final design which will be released in the coming months.

Further site investigations and survey works are now required to develop a further understanding of the existing road conditions. These works will also help inform the final design.

What to expect

These investigation works will be undertaken between 8pm Monday, 16 October 2023 and 5am on Tuesday, 17 October 2023 (weather permitting).

To safely undertake these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place on John Rice Avenue (near the existing pedestrian crossing). Please follow the directions of onsite traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling throughout the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding roads and properties.
