South Road Tram Overpass Upgrade

Stormwater survey

As part of the \$15.4 billion North-South Corridor, River Torrens to Darlington Project a rebuild of the tram overpass at South Road is required to facilitate the construction of the T2D motorway.

What's happening

Stormwater survey works will be undertaken from **Monday 9 December 2024** between **7am and 6pm** for up to two weeks. Works will occur in the roadways near South Road at the following locations:

- west bound lane of Anzac Highway, Glandore
- Nottingham Crescent, Glandore
- South Road, Black Forest
- Aroha Terrace, Black Forest.

How this affects you

There will be temporary changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please follow traffic management direction and onsite signage.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct you to alternative access and/or detours.

Outside of working hours, traffic will be reopened with all speed and lane restrictions removed. Access to properties will be maintained during the works at all times.

During these works there may be some noise disruptions, however we will minimise noise where possible.
