Frick Street Junction upgrade works

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of upcoming curve widening and road upgrade works at the junction of Frick Street and Mount Torrens Road, Lobethal, as part of the Lobethal Freight Route Access Project.

Works are scheduled to start on Thursday, 9 May, and are expected to be completed in late May, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken from 7am until 5pm each day, including weekends.

Scheduled works will be undertaken in three stages as follows:

Thursday, 9 May, to Sunday, 12 May

In this period the work site will be established, with traffic management in place. On **Saturday 11 May and Sunday 12 May** works will start on service installation and relocation. Entry and exit to and from Frick Street at Mount Torrens Road will be closed to all traffic. Traffic will be detoured via Ridge and Kumnick streets. **See attached detour map.**

Monday, 13 May, to Friday, 24 May

Kerb works are scheduled for the junction in this period. The Frick Street junction will be open to all traffic with speed and lane restrictions in place throughout the scheduled works.

Saturday, 25 May, to Tuesday, 28 May

On **Saturday, 25 May, and Sunday, 26 May**, pavement and asphalt works will occur. Entry and exit to and from Frick Street at Mount Torrens Road will be closed to all traffic. Traffic will be detoured via Ridge and Kumnick streets. **See attached detour map.**

Removal of construction materials and equipment is scheduled to occur on **Monday, 27 May**, and traffic management will be in place throughout this time.


Access to properties will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.
