

# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Hone Street temporary closure and nightworks

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, road lighting infrastructure installation works will soon be undertaken on Fullarton Road, between Glen Osmond Road and Hone Street, Parkside.

### What to expect

To minimise the impact to road users, **these works will be undertaken at night.**

Works are scheduled to be undertaken from **7pm Monday, 30 January to 6am Tuesday, 31 January 2023**, weather permitting.

To safely facilitate these works, **Hone Street will be temporarily closed at Fullarton Road during the works.**

Vehicles will be required to detour via Campbell Road and Collins Street, refer to the map overleaf for details. Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions.

There may be some impacts to private property driveways within the work zone. The project team will contact any affected property owners directly.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents. This includes scheduling more intrusive works in the early evening, where possible. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
