

Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Main Street and Hone Street temporary closures and nightworks

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, asphalt works will soon be undertaken on Fullarton Road at the junction with Main Street, Eastwood and Hone Street, Parkside.

What to expect

To minimise the impact to road users, **these works will be undertaken at night.**

The works at Main Street are scheduled to commence at 7pm Sunday, 23 July and be complete by 6am Monday, 24 July 2023, weather permitting.

To safely facilitate these works, **Main Street will be temporarily closed at Fullarton Road during working hours.** Vehicles will be required to detour via Elizabeth Street and Matilda Street or Markey Street and Glen Osmond Road. Refer to the map overleaf for details.

The works at Hone Street are scheduled to be undertaken:

- from 7pm Tuesday, 25 July until 6am Wednesday, 26 July 2023, weather permitting, and
- from 7pm Wednesday, 26 July until 6am Thursday, 27 July 2023, weather permitting.

To safely facilitate these works, **Hone Street will be temporarily closed at Fullarton Road during working hours.** Vehicles will be required to detour via Campbell Road and Collins Street. Refer to the map overleaf for details.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works, however the project team will contact individual property owners if driveway access is to be temporarily affected by the works.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphalt works are underway.

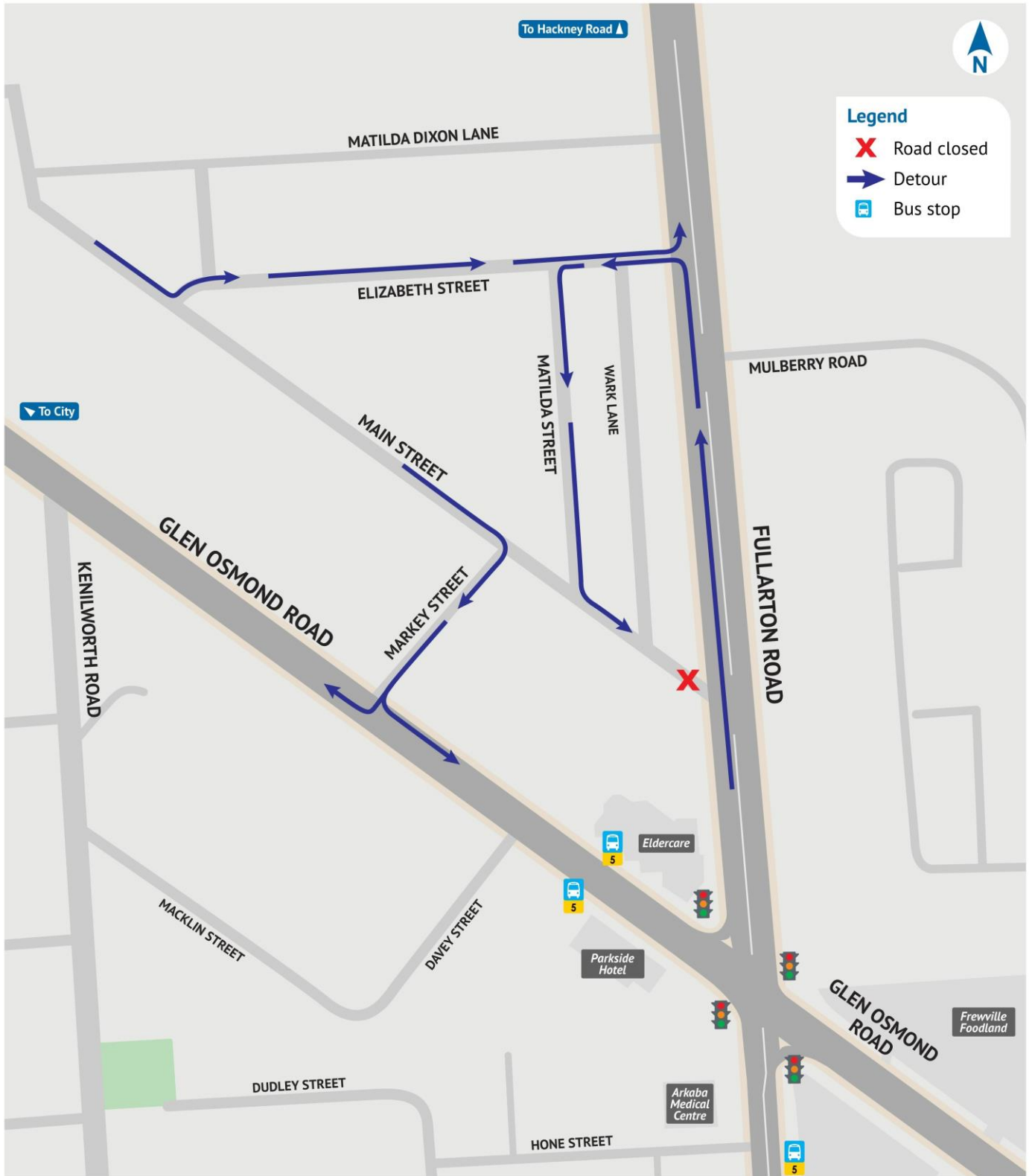
