

Beachport Jetty Upgrade

Finishing works

What's happening:

Minor works are currently being undertaken on Beachport jetty, including repairs to the fisherman's loading platform, structural timber beams and timber frames closest to the shore.

To safely facilitate these works, **Beachport jetty will be closed from Monday 19, February 2024 for approximately one week, weather permitting.**

To safely facilitate these activities short term speed restrictions will also be in place on Beach Road in the vicinity of the jetty to keep our works team safe.

How this affects you:

During this time pedestrian access to the jetty will be closed at all times. Access for boats to moor under the jetty will be limited to designated sections not subject to these works. Access to the berthing and refuelling platforms on the jetty will be available to the commercial fishing industry during the works.

Access to residential and business properties, as well as the Beachport foreshore, will be maintained at all times. Please continue to support local business.

Pedestrians and cyclists travelling along Beach Road are advised to take care. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.
