

# Morphett Road Investigation Activities

## Investigation Works Notice

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed funding towards planning to investigate the removal of the level crossing where the Glenelg tram line crosses Morphett Road, Morphettville. These works form part of the Tram Grade Separation Projects.

### What's happening:

Surveys and ground investigations are required to help inform further planning works.

Investigations will move progressively around the area and occur at multiple locations including Morphett Road, Anzac Highway and local side roads near the intersection and rail corridor. Some investigations are also required within the rail corridor.

### How this affects you:

Investigations will primarily be undertaken during the day and occur at each location for a short period of time. Some investigations will be required at night. More specific advance notice will be provided prior to any night works or works required for long periods of time in a certain area.

Access to properties will be maintained during the works wherever possible. We will provide advance local notification for residents and businesses if access to your property is to be temporarily impacted.

During these works there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions and onsite signage. Outside of working hours, traffic will be reopened with all speed and lane restrictions removed wherever possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restricted access. Signage will be in place to direct you to alternative access and/or detours.

Morphett Road and Anzac Highway near the level crossing and intersection and on local side roads including:

- Maxwell Terrace, Glengowrie
