



Main South Road Overtaking Lanes (Myponga to Cape Jervis)

Community Information Sessions

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly committed \$31.8 million (50:50) to improve safety for all road users on Main South Road by installing three new overtaking lanes between Myponga and Cape Jervis.

We recently confirmed the locations for the three new overtaking lanes:

- Between Second Valley and Normanville (northbound)
- Between Delamere and Second Valley (southbound)
- Between Cape Jervis and Delamere (northbound)

We are now progressing the designs for these overtaking lanes.
