

Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package

Main Road, Cherry Gardens – Works Update

We are delivering the Adelaide Hills Productivity and Road Safety Package to upgrade key strategic arterial roads in the region.

The road improvements will support economic growth, improve road safety and increase fire resilience. The \$150 million initiative is jointly funded by the Australian Government (80%) and South Australian Government (20%) over five years.

What's happening

We will be installing audio tactile line marking (ATLM) along the recently upgraded section of Main Road (between Black Road and Chandler Hill Road), Cherry Gardens.

ATLM is used to reduce “run-off-road” or cross carriageway crashes by creating a noise (audio) and vibratory (tactile) warning to road users who have strayed from the road lane.

How this affects you

Main Road will remain open during this work.

Works will move progressively along Main Road.

To do this work safely Main Road will be reduced to a single lane under speed restrictions immediately surrounding the work area.

Main Road between Black Road and Chandlers Hill Road, Cherry Gardens
