Barrier Highway Remediation works notice

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to the Barrier Highway

These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

What's happening

Major works on Barrier Highway, between Burra and Riverton, were completed in December 2024.

Minor remediation works are currently underway on a 4km stretch between Manoora and Saddleworth.

How this affects you

The Barrier Highway will remain open at all times.

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Speed restrictions will remain in place until all works are complete.

Traffic controllers will be on site to control the flow of traffic with temporary traffic signals in place during work hours.

During working hours, access to some side roads and driveways may be temporarily restricted. Advance notice of access impacts will be provided directly via our contractor.

We thank you for your understanding while we complete these important safety upgrades.
