Concept Design of Potts Road Roundabout

Dear Resident/Property Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to provide you with an update on the Gawler East Link Road Project.

Earlier this year the project team consulted with the community and stakeholders to provide feedback prior to the detailed design phase commencing.

This feedback has been considered and has resulted in some modifications to increase functionality and improve safety and amenity for all road users, pedestrians and cyclists.

The project will construct a new roundabout to connect Potts Road with the Gawler East Link Road.

The project scope at this location includes:

- Offset roundabout to allow for potential future extension of link road.
- One lane in each direction on approach to the roundabout intersection.
- Detention basin to improve filtration of storm water
- Amenity mound to improve noise mitigation and privacy.
- 50km/h speed limit.
- New asphalt surfacing and line marking.
- Improved pedestrian facilities including footpath and crossing points.
- On street bicycle lanes to the Gawler East Link Road.
- Shared environment paths around the roundabout- in which bicycles can mix safely with motor vehicle traffic.
- Light emitting diode (LED) lighting.
