Drainage works Birch Crescent, Tonsley

Dear Resident / Business Owner

As part of the Flinders Link Project, a new drainage line will be installed on the western side of Birch Crescent, Tonsley, between Sturt Road and Oak Avenue.

These works will be undertaken from Thursday, 15 August, to Wednesday, 21 August, between the hours of 7am and 5pm, excluding the weekend.

The works will involve excavation of a 20 metre trench, installation of new drainage, back-filling and reinstatement of asphalt.

To ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users while the works are undertaken a buffer zone will be implemented on the western side of Birch Crescent, adjacent the work area. Parking will be temporarily removed between Sturt Road and Oak Avenue from 4pm, Wednesday, 14 August, until the completion of works at 5pm, Wednesday, 21 August.

Traffic controllers will be on-site to assist motorists to safely access Birch Crescent while works are undertaken. Access to properties will be maintained at all times, under the direction of traffic controllers. Take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed restrictions when travelling through the area.
