Torrens Street and Crozier Road roundabout

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is installing a roundabout at the intersection of Torrens Street and Crozier Road, Victor Harbor, to improve road safety and traffic efficiency and to reduce the risk of rear end crashes.

We invite you to drop in to a Community Information Session to meet the project team and ask any questions you might have.

Victor Harbor CWA Hall, 17 Crozier Road, Victor Harbor**

The tender for works is expected to be awarded later this year, with construction scheduled to commence after the school holiday period. Works are expected to be completed by late April 2020, weather permitting.

To minimise traffic impacts, construction works will mostly be undertaken between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday however some weekend work may be required. Should night works be required, adjacent residents and businesses will be provided with advance notice.

All roads will remain open to traffic during construction, with a 25km/h speed restriction in place while workers are on-site. Road users are asked to use extra caution when workers are on site.

The department will make every effort to minimise impacts and will ensure that access to businesses and properties is maintained throughout the works.

The department appreciates your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
