Main South Road temporary traffic restrictions

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, changed traffic arrangements will be in place from 8pm Monday 23 to 6am Tuesday 24 March. Main South Road southbound will be closed between Shepherds Hill Road and Sutton Road, Bedford Park, in preparation for final asphalting works.

To safely facilitate these works the follow traffic managements will be in place from 8pm Monday 23 to 6am Tuesday 24 March:

- Southbound South Road motorists wanting to access Main South Road south of Sutton Road will
 be required to turn right onto the Tonsley Boulevard bridge and follow the detour onto the
 northbound carriageway of South Road. The detour will extend to the southbound carriageway at
 the Sutton / Mimosa bridge (see blue arrows on map overleaf).
- Southbound Ayliffes Road motorists wanting to access Main South Road south of Sutton Road
 will be required to turn right onto South Road and then left onto the Tonsley Boulevard bridge and
 follow the detour onto the northbound carriageway of South Road. The detour will extend to the
 southbound carriageway at the Sutton / Mimosa bridge (see blue arrows on map overleaf).
- Northbound Main South Road traffic will be detoured via Sturt Road and Shepherds Hill Road (see red arrows on map overleaf).
- The exit ramp from the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) northbound to access Tonsley Boulevard will be closed, motorist can access Tonsley Boulevard via the northbound surface road detour.
- Mimosa Terrace will be closed at the junction of Main South Road during these works, access for local residents will be via Birch Crescent and Maple Avenue.
- Sutton Road will be restricted to a left out to travel southbound only.
- Tonsley Boulevard will be restricted to a left out to travel northbound only.
- Bus stop 25A (southbound) on Main South Road will be temporarily closed.
- Bus stop 26 and 24A (northbound) on South Road will be temporarily closed.
- Bus stop 24A (southbound) on South Road will only be serviced by some bus services during this time

Access for emergency services vehicles will be maintained at all times during the temporary traffic restrictions. On-site traffic controllers will be in place to direct vehicles as required.

Pedestrians are reminded to keep clear of the work zones, however traffic management will be in place throughout the closure to assist with pedestrian movements. Cyclists will be detoured as per the detour for motorists.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
