



# Angle Vale Riverbanks College Junction Upgrades

## Changed traffic conditions and upcoming works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering local road improvements to support the construction of the new Riverbanks College B-12 in Angle Vale. This upgrade is funded by the South Australian Government and will improve the safety and efficiency for all road users near the College.

Upcoming works include the placement of the final layer of asphalt, installation of traffic signals and line marking on Angle Vale Road, Riverbanks Road and Frisby Road at Angle Vale.

To safely facilitate these works, the junction of **Frisby Road with Angle Vale Road will be temporarily closed**, with a traffic detour in place at the following times, weather permitting:

- **7am Monday, 22 November to 6pm Tuesday, 23 November, 2021; and**
- **7am to 6pm on Monday, 6 December, 2021.**

Please see detour map over the page and onsite signage for more details. Works will be undertaken each day between 7am and 6pm however the temporary detour will remain in place outside of these work hours.

A 40 km/h speed restriction will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Lane and other speed restrictions may apply, subject to on site conditions. Road users are asked to plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to properties, including Angle Vale Primary School and the Angle Vale Community Sports Centre, will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict access.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.

Project completion is expected in time for the 2022 school year, weather permitting.
