



# Majors Road Interchange

## Project Update – December 2024

**We're building a new connection to the Southern Expressway, improving access, travel times and supporting growth in the southern suburbs**

Works continue to progress well at the new interchange. This project update provides an overview of key activities coming up, including a temporary closure of Majors Road (immediately east of Adams Road) in January 2025. Final project completion is expected at the end of 2025.

### Works to date

Works recently completed include:

- installation of 18 steel bridge girders
- the concrete deck pour for the widened section of the Majors Road bridge
- traffic switched onto southern side of Majors Road to allow for earthworks on the northern side
- 1.5km of common service trenching along Majors Road
- light pole installation along Majors Road and the northbound on-ramp.

## Upcoming works

Over the coming months, we will be undertaking the following works:

- Traffic switch onto the widened section of the Majors Road bridge
- asphalting of the southbound on and off ramps
- asphalting of the eastbound portion of Majors Road
- Adams Road, Majors Road and Morphet Track intersection works
- demolition of old retaining walls in preparation for construction of the northbound off-ramp
- continued works of the new Veloway underpass below Majors Road.

## How this affects you

To keep you safe, speed and lane restrictions will continue along Majors Road and the Southern Expressway.

The majority of works will continue during the day between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Saturday.

To minimise impacts to traffic flow, occasional night works will continue to be undertaken. We will let you know in advance when these night works are required via variable message signs (VMS). Local stakeholders, including Emergency Services, will be notified directly in advance.

## Temporary Majors Road closure

Majors Road, immediately east of Adams Road, will be temporarily closed between **Monday 13 January and Friday 24 January 2025**. This will allow us to safely undertake earthworks, pavement construction and asphalt works prior to switching traffic onto the new widened section of the Majors Road bridge.

During this time, a temporary detour will be in place. Further information will be provided closer to the date.

## Traffic switch onto Majors Road bridge

Following the temporary road closure, Majors Road will be temporarily switched onto the new widened section of the Majors Road bridge with one lane of traffic maintained in each direction.

This switch is required to prepare for the start of earthworks on the northern side of Majors Road, between Sam Willoughby BMX facility and Glenthorne National Park–Ityamaiipinna Yarta.

## Shutdown during holiday period

There will be no works on site between Friday 20 December 2024 and Monday 6 January 2025.

## Civil Train SA School Tour

In November 2024, Civil Train SA, in collaboration with Renewal SA and the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, hosted Year 9 and 10 students from Aldinga High School for a site tour and morning tea.

The event provided an opportunity for the Project Team to share information about the Majors Road Interchange Project and their experiences on a career in the construction industry.
