

# Portrush and Magill Roads Intersection Upgrade

The Australian and South Australian governments are jointly funding the \$98 million upgrade of the Portrush and Magill roads intersection.

The Portrush and Magill roads intersection is part of the National Land Transport Network and forms part of the Outer Ring Route, which is a major traffic and freight route. With an Annual Average Daily Traffic of approximately 60,200 vehicles through the intersection, the existing intersection is currently operating at capacity in both the AM and PM peak periods, with signal phasing and traffic lanes fully utilised, creating congestion and causing safety risks.

## About the demolition works

- The demolition works are being undertaken by the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's prequalified contractors.
- These works are being undertaken along the western side Portrush Road and Magill Road to facilitate the new intersection upgrade.

- In addition to the demolition works, an asbestos assessment is being completed and any identified asbestos will be removed. All asbestos removal works will be carried out by a licensed asbestos contractor in accordance with the Environmental Protection Authority Guidelines. These measures will ensure the safety of the community and workers.
- Existing structures (i.e. garages and sheds) located on boundaries will be replaced with a 'like for like' fence, if required.
- The works are being undertaken in stages.
- Prior to the demolition works commencing on each property, temporary fencing is being installed around properties for safety reasons and utility service disconnections are being undertaken.
- Security patrols have been engaged to maintain a presence throughout the project area. Police patrols will also monitor the project area and can be contacted on 131444, or 000 in an emergency situation.

## Dust Management

- Demolition works may create some short-term disturbance to nearby residents. Dust cannot be completely eliminated, however measures are being put in place works to minimise the impacts of dust, as much as practically possible.
