

# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Project Update

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

Major works to widen the intersection are well underway on the north-western and south-western corners, with traffic expected to be shifted onto the new intersection alignment in February 2023, weather permitting.

### Christmas break - site shutdown

There will be a site shutdown over the holiday period, between Friday, 23 December 2022 and Tuesday, 2 January 2023, when there will be no works undertaken.

### Main Avenue realignment

As part of the project, the section of Main Avenue, between Chessington Avenue and Glen Osmond Road, is being realigned. Traffic signals will also be installed at the junction of Glen Osmond Road and Main Avenue.

Main Avenue realignment works have been underway since late August 2022 and the new junction is expected to be open to traffic in early 2023.

### Night works – continuing

Night works will continue to be undertaken in various locations through and around the intersection, as required between the hours of 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday, until early 2023.

Due to significant wet weather in recent months, the project team will be undertaking works on Friday nights for a short period to ensure our program of works stay on track ahead of the holiday closure period.

Some works may also need to be undertaken on Saturday nights and in adjacent side streets. At least one respite night, where no works are undertaken, will be provided each week.

Advance notice of future night works in 2023, will be provided as works progress.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works during the day or early evening where possible.

You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

The project team will contact individual property owners whose access is affected by the works.
