ML advised public art is of the scope of the Darlington Project and information will be available shortly.</li> </ul> <p><b>John</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When will the Flinders Link Project be opening? NW advised in mid-2020.</li> </ul>	<b>ACTION</b>
<b>3. Work Health and Safety</b>	<p><b>Suzi</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pothole on the southbound/westbound of Ayliffes Road requires fixing up.</li> </ul>	<b>ACTION</b>
<b>4. Project Update</b>	<p><b>Julian Mutinelli provided the below update of current works:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Southern end requires last layer of asphalt, due to be complete over the coming months</li> <li>Ongoing construction of surface road to final design, this will continue through to next year.</li> <li>Major traffic switch which included the opening of the Ayliffes Road bridge to traffic occurred last weekend. Switch went well now smoother run from Main South Road to Ayliffes Road city bound.</li> <li>On-going remediation works on revetment walls on the eastern side of the lowered motorway.</li> </ul>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Final layers of asphalt to be laid in early 2020</li> <li>Landscaping ongoing through the project</li> </ul> <p><b>Upcoming works:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Traffic open under Tonsley bridge for northbound traffic</li> <li>Main South Road surface roads completed to final design</li> <li>Final kerbing works</li> <li>Landscaping ongoing</li> <li>Final cycle path and bus stop works</li> </ul>	
<b>5. Flinders Link Update</b>	<p><b>Neil Welsh provided the below update:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Construction has commenced for the pedestrian walkway between Oak Avenue and Brayden Court.</li> <li>Piling works are currently occurring adjacent Flinders Medical Centre for the elevated walkway.</li> <li>Construction of 4 piers have now been poured.</li> <li>First bridge girder installation 22 - 25 November.</li> <li>Second girder installation 6 - 9 December.</li> <li>Abutment A (Sturt Road) and abutment B (Flinders Oval) works progressing well.</li> <li>Tonsley line review is currently with the Minister's office, information regarding the feedback from the consultation will be publically available once this has been approved.</li> </ul> <p><b>John</b> – is there an update on new Tonsley station? NW advised that we are hoping for an announcement shortly.</p> <p><b>Irene</b> - Pedestrian access between Birch Crescent and Lynton Ave is still accessible even though there is signage in place to say it is 'closed'. The alternative access which has been provided along Sturt Road is not safe. DPTI to follow up and investigate to ensure the area is safe.</p> <p><b>Daryl</b> – Will Flinders Link be the same urban design as Darlington? NW advised that the urban design will differentiate due to the difference between road and rail projects.</p> <p><b>Suzi</b> – Can there be a connection path through Renewal SA land? NW advised this isn't possible.</p>	<b>ACTION</b>
<b>6. Round The Table</b>	<p><b>John Arthur</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Graffiti needs to be removed along the section of the bridges that are over the Southern Expressway, on the on ramps/ walls.</li> </ul> <p><b>Daryl</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bus Stop 24A (eastern side) near Ragless Reserve not using indent bus bay. GS/DPTI to follow up.</li> <li>The land under Ayliffes Road Bridge be used for? JM advised that this will be non-used land/ some sections will be landscaped.</li> </ul> <p><b>Yvonne</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Will there be car parking for the new Flinders station/ New Tonsley station?
