

# Military Road Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

## Start of construction

As part of the State Government's election commitment to enhance pedestrian safety, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport will design and install a pedestrian actuated crossing on Military Road, between St Albans Terrace and Jena Close, Semaphore Park. Funding of \$1.1 million has been allocated to this project.

The pedestrian actuated crossing will be installed on Military Road between St Albans Terrace and Recreation Parade, immediately to the north of Jena Close. The new crossing will improve access to Point Malcolm Reserve and contribute to improved safety when crossing Military Road. Works will include:

- installation of a pedestrian actuated (push button) crossing;
- removal of existing and replacement with new ramps and median cut outs;
- pavement resurfacing within the extent of the works;
- upgraded road lighting; and
- new pedestrian fencing.

### What to expect

Following the recent completion of required early works, construction of the Military Road pedestrian actuated crossing is scheduled to commence from Monday, 10 July 2023 (weather permitting). Project completion is expected in late September 2023 (**weather permitting**).

Works will be undertaken between 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday and on Saturdays as required. If night works are required, advance notice will be provided to residents in the vicinity of the works. To safely facilitate these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours. Please follow the directions of on-site traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Access to Jena Close will be maintained at all times, under the direction of traffic controllers. Outside of work hours, some speed and lane restrictions may be required as per onsite conditions.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the work sites and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

### School bus stops

The school bus stops located on both the eastern and western side of Military Road will remain accessible for the duration of the works.

Access to properties near the work area will be maintained during the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. Access will be maintained for emergency services vehicles at all times. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible. We appreciate your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
