We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, and urban roads, footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia

The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over three years.

What's happening

We are installing a new pedestrian refuge on Old Princes Highway, near Childs Road in Littlehampton, to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity.

These works include:

- construction of a new pedestrian refuge, with new pedestrian ramps on both approaches to the refuge
- new line marking
- new road signage

How this affects you

To do this work safely there will be speed and lane restrictions in place during working hours. Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours, and until line marking is completed in December 2024.

Please follow onsite signage and traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Access for heavy vehicles will be maintained at all times.
