



# Victor Harbor Road and Main South Road Duplication Projects

## Site Investigation Works – Update

Dear Resident / Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is continuing site investigation works for the Victor Harbor Road and Main South Road duplication projects.

Site investigations are required to better understand the existing conditions and will include:

- Location and deeping of underground services.
- Geotechnical investigations.
- Environmental investigations including flora and fauna surveys and noise monitoring.
- Aboriginal and cultural heritage assessment.

**Works will occur intermittently over the coming months.**

The investigation sites do not necessarily correspond to areas which will be impacted by the project in the final design. The locations have been carefully chosen to minimise disruption to the community and for the best overall understanding of local conditions.

Night works will occur on Victor Harbor Road and Main South Road from Monday, 29 March to Thursday, 1 April 2021, then again from Monday, 12 April to Saturday, 17 April 2021. These works will be undertaken as night works when traffic volumes are lower, **between the hours of 7pm and 7am each night** and will occur at the following locations:

Victor Harbor Road

- Between Main South Road, Old Noarlunga and Robinson Road, Seaford Heights

Main South Road

- Between Malpas Road and Port Road, Aldinga

Other site investigations will also occur during the daytime between the hours of **7am and 7pm**.

All roads will remain open, with some localised speed and lane restrictions in place. Road users are advised to take extra care when workers are on site, and observe signage when travelling through the
