

Road Safety Program

RM Williams Way, Jamestown to Spalding

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to RM Williams Way between Jamestown and Spalding. These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 2 years.

What's happening:

Works will include shoulder widening and sealing, pavement rehabilitation and safety barrier installation. The upgrades are designed to improve safety, freight efficiency, and support regional economic growth.

How this affects you:

Works will commence from Jamestown and move progressively south towards Spalding. To do this work safely we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours speed and lane restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

You will still be able to access homes and properties. If we need to limit or impact access, we'll contact property owners ahead of time. If you have any questions regarding access, we encourage you to contact us to discuss.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.
