

# Brighton Road and Edwards Street Junction upgrade

## Ongoing early works

The Australian and South Australian governments are upgrading the Brighton Road and Edwards Street junction at South Brighton.

Early works are continuing with further service relocation activities required for SA Power Networks infrastructure, APA Gas infrastructure and telecommunications infrastructure, and site enabling works in close proximity to the junction.

### What to expect

These works are planned to start on **Wednesday, 14 June 2023 with completion in mid August 2023 (weather permitting)**. The majority of these works will be undertaken intermittently during the day between 7am to 7pm, Monday to Saturday. No works will be undertaken on Sundays.

### Night works

**To safely undertake these works, some night works and a temporary road closure will also be required.**

SA Power Networks infrastructure works will be undertaken on **Wednesday, 14 June 2023** between 7pm and 6am (weather permitting).

To safely facilitate these works the **junction of Brighton Road and Edwards Street will be temporarily closed during these works**. During this time, motorists will need to detour via Marlborough Street, Commercial Road or Oleander Street East, Scott Street. Speed and lane restrictions will also be in place in the vicinity of the works. Local access to Edwards Street residents and businesses will be maintained via the detour. Refer to the map overleaf for traffic detour information.

Site enabling works and telecommunications infrastructure works will be undertaken for three nights **Monday, 19 June to Wednesday, 21 June 2023 between 7pm to 6am** (weather permitting).

**The junction will remain open to traffic during these night works with speed and lane restrictions in place in the vicinity of the works.**

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. No changes to public transport services are planned during these works.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
