

North-South Corridor Darlington Upgrade Project

Temporary closure of Brookman Avenue, Bedford Park

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project utility services works will be undertaken along Brookman Avenue, Quinlan Avenue and Paul Street, St Marys.

Works will be undertaken from 6am Monday 5 June 2017, until early July 2017.

To safely facilitate these works, Brookman Avenue will be temporarily closed at the junction with South Road from 6am Monday 5 June 2017, for approximately one week.

Key activities:

- Excavation of the road to install electrical conduits.
- Backfill of excavation to reinstate the road.
- Boring underneath the road and footpath.

Excavators, crane, trucks, boring rig and a saw cutter will be used to undertake these works.

Works will occur between the hours of 7am and 7pm.

Traffic management

- While Brookman Avenue is closed, vehicles will be detoured via Quinlan Avenue and Paul Street.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Lane and speed restrictions will apply in the vicinity of the works.
- Signage will alert motorists to the changed traffic conditions.

Works will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents however some noise can be expected.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed and lane restrictions when travelling through the area.
