

# Lefevre Peninsula Upgrades Project

## Background

The northern Lefevre Peninsula is one of the key economic growth areas in South Australia. To support the development of this region, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading transport infrastructure in the area.

This \$53.5 million upgrade will benefit local residents, visitors and workers by increasing the capacity of the road network. The upgrade will include supporting the defence expansion at Osborne, as well as other industries already established on the peninsula and improve future heavy vehicle access to the port.

Upgrades will include:

- a realignment and upgrade of the junction of Victoria Road and Pelican Point Road;
- upgrades to the Victoria Road and Veitch Road junction;
- upgraded pedestrian crossings linking with paths to the Kardi Yarta playground, Biodiversity Park and defence industry car parks;
- improved bike lanes and footpaths and new landscaping adjacent to the upgrades; and
- new LED road lighting, line marking and drainage.

Targeted pavement rehabilitation works will also be undertaken on sections of Victoria Road between Oliver Rogers Road, North Haven and Indarra Street, Taperoo. Please see concept overleaf.

These upgrades form part of a \$100 million commitment to road and rail infrastructure improvements on the Lefevre Peninsula. Jointly funded by the South Australian and Australian governments (50:50) it will support the creation of 205 jobs per year for the life of the project.

## Project timing

Major construction is expected to commence late 2023 and be completed in late 2024.

## Current works

Site investigation activities have commenced. The information collected as part of these works will help inform the project's design.

## Biodiversity Park

While a small portion of Biodiversity Park will be required for the project, the proposed design allows for new open space, landscaping and revegetation. We are committed to working with key stakeholders and the local community to ensure vegetation and landscaping plans further enhance the area.

## Community engagement

Community and stakeholder engagement is important for the successful delivery of this project. As part of the ongoing planning, the Project Team will be in Osborne to meet with the community and answer any questions you may have.
