

Yorktown Road and Adams Road Roundabout

Site investigation works

Site investigation works continue for the South Australian Government's \$1.5 million project to plan, design and construct a roundabout at the Yorktown Road and Adams Road junction in Craigmore.

We received valuable feedback from the local community over the last several months. This feedback will help inform the detailed design, and we thank everyone who provided feedback. Once an updated concept design is ready, we will provide further updates.

Road condition assessments and surveying works are being undertaken, to develop a further understanding of the existing road conditions.

What to expect

Works will be undertaken on Monday, 8 May 2023 between 7:30am to 4:00pm, weather permitting.

To safely undertake these works speed and lane restrictions will be in place on Adams Road. Please follow the directions of on-site traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling throughout the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts on the community.

Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and roads.
