

Cape Jervis and Kangaroo Island Ports Upgrade

Penneshaw works update

We're upgrading the Penneshaw and Cape Jervis ports, building better connections between KI and the mainland

This project is funded by the South Australian Government.

What's happening

Works to construct the upgraded berthing and mooring infrastructure at Penneshaw are underway. From Tuesday 17 September construction of new anchor blocks, which will form the foundation of the new infrastructure, and associated piling will commence.

Piling works will be undertaken intermittently during this time. Onsite signage will advise of the next upcoming piling shift.

To ensure everyone's safety, and access to ferry services is maintained, some of these works will be undertaken at night, in addition to the day works schedule.

How this affects you

Some noise can be expected; however, we will make every effort to minimise impacts as much as possible.

We are utilising a 'bored' piling method where possible, enabling piles to be installed directly into pre-bored holes. This type of piling produces less noise compared to driven piles. More information about piling can be found in the Frequently Asked Questions at www.dit.sa.gov.au/KIPorts

Lighting will be directed towards work areas only, and the noisiest works will be undertaken in the early evening where possible. We encourage you to subscribe for project updates and notifications to stay informed about future works.
