# Glen Osmond Road, Kenilworth Road, Young Street intersection pedestrian improvements

**Works** notice

We are improving safety at the pedestrian crossing on Glen Osmond Road adjacent the Parkside Primary School.

The project is one of eight locations across South Australia that we've identified for an upgrade as part of our broader strategy to improve road safety for pedestrians, particularly children walking to and from school.

## What's happening

We are undertaking safety improvement works on the pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Glen Osmond Road, Kenilworth Road and Young Street to enhance safety for all road users, particularly school children crossing Glen Osmond Road. Please refer to the concept overleaf.

Early works, including service location and surveying, will be undertaken from Thursday 7 November 2024. These works will be undertaken during the day under localised speed and lane restrictions.

#### Construction will start from Monday 11 November 2024.

These works will be undertaken during the day, from Monday to Friday with some Saturday works required, and at night from Sunday to Thursday.

### When

Thursday 7 November 2024 to late January 2025, weather permitting.

Day works Monday to Friday 7am to 5pm

**Night works** Sunday to Thursday 6pm to 6am

Intersection of Glen Osmond Road, Kenilworth Road and Young Street, Parkside.

## How this affects you

To do these works safely, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions for the duration of the project. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area including outside of work hours.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained. If temporary access restrictions are required affected property owners, residents and businesses will be contacted directly in advance.





#### **OFFICIAL**

Additional traffic restrictions will be in place from **Monday 11 November 2024** for the duration of the project:

- Access to Kenilworth Road, from Glen Osmond Road, will be closed to all traffic.
- During the day there will be no access to Glen Osmond Road from Young Street. You will still be able to turn into Young Street from Glen Osmond Road during day works.
- At night the intersection of Young Street and Glen Osmond Road will be closed to all traffic.
- Local detours will be in place for the duration of works. Please follow onsite signage for alternative routes and observe the direction of onsite traffic controllers.
- Speed and lane restrictions will be in place on Glen Osmond Road for the duration of the project.


## The Parkside Primary School and St Raphaels School kiss and drop will remain accessible throughout the project.

Pedestrian and cyclist routes may be impacted as works progress. Onsite signage will help guide you to alternative routes.


Some noise can be expected while these works are undertaken, but we'll do our best to keep impacts to the local community to a minimum.
