Dukes Highway – Works Notice

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over 10 years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

What's happening

We will be carrying out resurfacing works on a two-kilometre section of the Dukes Highway, north of Keith, starting at the Riddoch Highway junction.

We will be working on the following dates:

- Tuesday, 7 January 2025
- Monday, 13 January 2025 to Thursday, 16 January 2025
- Thursday, 23 January 2025

These improvements will enhance the road surface and increase safety for all road users.

How this affects you

During working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the work area. Please follow onsite traffic signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours, speed restrictions will remain in place as required, dependent on onsite conditions.
